# Emergency Medical Technicians, Law Enforcement Personnel, Firefighters, Dispatchers and Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technicians (EODT).

Each year, the Veterans of Foreign Wars selects emergency medical technicians, law enforcement, firefighter, dispatcher and explosive ordnance disposal technicians' personnel to receive VFW Public Servant Awards.

Post Safety Chairpersons are to submit a candidate for these awards to Department Headquarters by December 15th.

### **VFW National Emergency Medical Technician Public Servant Citation:**

Any individual, who actively gives emergency medical treatment, provides rescue service or civil disaster assistance as a member of any public or volunteer company organized to give emergency medical care, provide rescue and civil disaster assistance to our nation's citizens.

#### **VFW National Law Enforcement Public Servant Citation:**

Any individual, who serves in a municipal, county, state or federal unit tasked with enforcement of the laws pertaining to their area of responsibility. This award does not apply to individuals employed by private companies or security services.

#### **VFW National Firefighters Public Servant Citation:**

Any individual, who actively fights fires as a member of any public or volunteer company organized to fight fires and give assistance to our nation's citizens.

#### VFW National 911 Dispatcher Public Servant Citation:

Any individual, who serves in a municipal, county, state or federal unit tasked with providing the vital link between callers in distress and emergency response teams by obtaining essential information to send the appropriate responders to the right location.

#### VFW National Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technician Public Servant Citation:

Any individual, who serves in a municipal, county, state or federal unit tasked with the enforcement of the laws and special handling pertaining to disposal of explosive threats to our nation's citizens.

#### **Documentation required for all Candidates:**

- 1) Nomination letter from the post commander, containing the candidate's name, title, address, telephone and identifying the award for which the individual should be considered.
- 2) One (1) page resume of the candidate's overall background.
- 3) One (1) page resume of the candidate's background in their field.

- 4) One (1) page listing of the candidate's accomplishment and awards in their field.
- 5) Photograph (preferably a head shot) of the candidate.
- 6) NEW One (1) page VFW Public Servant Award Citation Post Entry Form is now available under the VFW website log in to assist in obtaining nominations

Post Safety Chairperson should send the above information to their Department Headquarters to arrive no later than December 15.
