The MCVA reserves the right to reject or dismiss any entry, which violates the below stated Rules and Regulation. Furthermore, the MCVA reserves the right to deny participation in Further Parades by groups/bands ignoring and/or violating these Parade Rules and Regulations.

Throwing OF Candy And/Or Handouts: To Avoid the risk of possible injury, the throwing of candy or any other items from a vehicle is strictly prohibited. Any Items you wish to distribute to the crowed MUST be handed out from someone walking alongside your entry. We do not want any children running into the street in front of vehicles. CANDY MAY NOT BE TOSSES INTO A CROWED.

NOISE: All units will be required to keep the blowing of horns, sirens, and whistles at a minimal volume throughout the Parade route. Top quality bands have been contracted at considerable expanse, and are placed throughout the Parade so as not to compete with each other or loud and distracting noises. All entries must indicate if they have music or sound amplifying systems, and shall maintain a volume that will not interfere with other entries, especially those with animals. If a unit is informed by the Parade marshal(s) or the police that the noise generated by their unit is too loud, they shall immediately turn the volume down or take other steps identified by the Parade marshal or the police.

About Pennsylvania Wounded Warriors

We are an independent statewide nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization providing support to Pennsylvania Wounded Warriors and their families and Veterans in Crisis. Our unpaid staff consists entirely of volunteers who donate their time and expertise on behalf of Pennsylvania's veterans. A very small percentage of our budget goes to administrative costs. We are not affiliated with nor a part of the national organization Wounded Warrior Project and we do not receive any funds from them. Our ability to help Pennsylvania veterans is financially supported by generous donations from individuals, local, civic and business groups, schools, churches and individual veterans organizations such as VFW, American Legion, DAV, Vietnam Veterans, etc.

How We Help

Pennsylvania's veterans have served their nation in every conflict. Many of those men and women are recovering physically, mentally or emotionally at a military hospital, Veteran's Administration medical facility or with their families at home and in need of financial support.

Through generous donations we are able to help them with payments such as mortgage/rent, security deposits, utilities, home/vehicle repair and medical and education expenses not covered under current government programs. We can also help with temporary housing to prevent a veteran from becoming homeless while in transition to permanent housing. We pay directly to vendors and creditors not to the veteran most Innusual in except circumstances. We ask that Veterans in need of assistance first contact a local VA office or County Veterans Office or similar Veterans Service Agency. Our volunteers will work directly with the social/case worker assigned to you to support your request.

Throughout the year our staff will donate their time to visit our veterans in military facilities to thank them for their service. We provide them with literature on our programs and information on additional organizations within Pennsylvania who can also provide assistance and others that provide recreational activities for veterans. We also distribute small gifts such foods. Pennsylvania homemade quilts, iTunes cards, etc.

Sponsorship & Fundraising

We do not use a paid telemarketer, direct mail or fundraising consultant. Our only fundraising event is our annual Wounded Warrior Gala held in October to honor our veterans. This allows our volunteers to dedicate their time completely to helping our wounded warriors and veterans in crisis transition through difficult times. Therefore, we individual welcome any organization interested in sponsoring a fundraising event to contact us. We will provide them with our brochures/ posters and help publicize their efforts through our facebook site and public appearance.
